<p><b>Arrival &amp; Dismissal Procedures</b></p> <p><b>Arrival</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be placed in groups outside based on their Grade Level.</li> <li>• Areas have been marked in front of each exterior doorway in the front of the building.</li> <li>• Students must remain 6 ft apart while outside.</li> <li>• Students will enter at the <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Grade 8- Main Entrance</li> <li>○ Grade 7- Middle of the Building</li> <li>○ Grade 6- Golden Lion Café entrance.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Please follow all directions of LMS Faculty</li> <li>• Parents do not enter the bus loop.</li> </ul> <p><b>Dismissal</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be dismissed at 2:50.</li> <li>• Walkers and Car Rides will be called first.</li> <li>• PARENTS: Please avoid blocking traffic and do not enter the bus loop.</li> <li>• Students will exit using the hallway closest to them and immediately get on their bus.</li> <li>• After buses have left the bus loop, we will dismiss walkers and car riders.</li> <li>• All students must vacate the premises as quickly as possible.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Screening &amp; Testing (<i>Safety is Our True North</i>)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All families should screen students for symptoms prior to leaving home.</li> <li>• Please use this <a href="#">checklist</a> to determine if a student should or should not go to school.</li> <li>• Persons with COVID-19 symptoms in school will be required to be tested or will be placed on quarantine, in alignment with guidance from the Maryland Department of Health.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Face Covering (<i>Safety is Our True North</i>)</b></p> <p><b>Requirements:</b> All persons, regardless of vaccination status, must wear a face covering while inside a school. Exceptions to this requirement are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The person is alone in a private space.</li> <li>• The person is eating or drinking.</li> <li>• The person has a documented physical or developmental disability that makes wearing a mask unsafe.</li> <li>• The person is under the age of two.</li> <li>• The person is a student athlete engaged in the sport in the field of play.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Social Distancing (<i>Safety is Our True North</i>)</b></p> <p><b>Requirements:</b> Physical distancing of students from each other and between students and adults will be provided to the greatest extent possible, considering school enrollment and facility constraints. Strategies include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use of classroom and cafeteria configurations that provide maximal separation between students.</li> <li>• Plans for arrival, dismissal and change of classes to reduce gathering of students in any area.</li> <li>• Restriction of field trips to day trips only, with plans to reduce exposure to large crowds.</li> <li>• Plans for supervision of restrooms, locker rooms, and school lockers to prevent congregation of students.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Hand Hygiene (<i>Safety is Our True North</i>)</b></p> <p><b>Requirements:</b> Employees and students have been instructed to adhere to best practices in hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette.</p> <p>Times for handwashing or use of hand sanitizer to include before and after meals, upon arrival to schools' offices and home, before and after use of any shared items, after use of the restroom, after sneezing/coughing and other time hands are contaminated.</p>	<p><b>Breakfast &amp; Lunch</b></p> <p><b>Breakfast</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will enter in their assigned door.</li> <li>• Breakfast is Grab and Go</li> <li>• Breakfast is Free; No money or PIN numbers are needed</li> <li>• Students will go to homeroom.</li> <li>• Once seated, students may remove mask and eat breakfast.</li> <li>• When finished, place trash in bag, replace mask; wait for teacher instruction to dispose of trash.</li> </ul> <p><b>Lunch</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lunch is Free; No Money or PIN numbers needed.</li> <li>• Students will be escorted to lunch by a teacher in a social distant line.</li> <li>• Students have assigned seats in the café.</li> <li>• They will enter through the back door and go through the line and report to their assigned seat.</li> <li>• Once seated they may remove their mask and eat.</li> <li>• When finished students replace mask and place trash in front of them.</li> </ul>

<b>What to bring to school</b>	<b>What to leave at home</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To visit a BCPS school, visitors must have an appointment.</li> <li>Visits will be conducted remotely or outside, whenever possible.</li> <li>If an indoor visit is required, visitors will be required to wear a face covering and practice social distancing.</li> <li>The number of people admitted to the building will be limited.</li> </ul>

Information regarding these activities will be shared with students during the first few weeks back at school.</li> <li>Permission slips will be required for all after school activities.</li> </ul>		<b>Requirements:</b> BCPS staff will continue to provide safe and clean school environments by ensuring daily cleaning of buildings using Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approved germicidal agents that kill coronavirus. BCPS staff will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Perform frequent cleaning and disinfection of high-contact surfaces and any shared items, at least daily.</li> <li>Promote hand washing before and after touch of shared use items.</li> <li>Maintain sufficient supplies of soap, paper towels, and hand sanitizer.</li> </ul>
